

NTSE 2015 (Stage-1) Expert Opinion

Test paper of NTSE Stage-1 comprises of two sections:

- 1. Mental Ability Test (MAT)
- 2. Language Comprehensive Test (LCT)
- 3. Scholastic Aptitude Test (SAT)

This year NTSE Stage - 1 MAT paper seems to be on little difficult side and SAT paper was quite easy.

Mental Ability Test (MAT):

Total Questions: 50 Duration: 45 minutes

The paper is average & some questions are too easy. There is not a single controversial question.

Language Test (English):

Total Questions: 40 Duration: 45 Minutes

All questions were easy and there was not a single controversial question.

Scholastic Aptitude Test (SAT)

This section was quite easy comprising of 35 questions from Social Science, 35 questions from Science (Physics, Chemistry & Biology) & 20 questions from Maths. In all SAT was easy almost all questions from 10th and 9th NCERT. It was based on basic & fundamental knowledge.

Let us focus on the subject-wise analysis.

Science:

Physics: Out of 12 questions 3 questions from light & 3 from force. Paper was overall easy and based on fundamentals. Most of questions are from our module.

Chemistry: The Paper was vert easy. No tricky question. All were direct answer questions. Out of 11 question only 3 from IX class syllabus while the rest were from X class syllabus.

Biology: Questions were based on ix and X NCERT, and level was moderate. There were two questions which were based on previous year fundamentals.

Mathematics:

The Paper was vert moderat. No tricky question. Out of 20 question only 8 question are very easy & 10 questions are average & only 2 questions are hard.

Social Science:

The Paper was easy. No tricky question. All were direct answer questions. Out of 35 question 17 from IX class syllabus & 17 from X class syllabus & 1 from GK.

This question paper required practice and spontaneity of a student to develop a suitable logic which comes only from consistent practice. As per the views of our faculty members the paper was balanced & covering all the topics of IX & X NCERT. In all MAT will be determining section for the success of aspirants.
