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

About PCCP DIVISION



- Resonance launched Pre-foundation Career Care Programs (PCCPs) Division in 2006 with the philosophy of an early start. As the name suggests, the division aims at giving an edge to the students for Career Examinations like JEE (Main + Advanced), NEET/ AllMS, CA/CS/CLAT etc. before entering into senior secondary classes.
- In last 12 years, PCCP division has evolved significantly and works in two segments of classes, namely, Sub-Junior classes (V VIII) and Junior classes (IX X). The two segments have different teaching methodologies and so are their targets.
- In junior classes, the targeted competitive examinations are National Standard Examination in Junior Science (NSEJS, 1st stage of International Junior Science Olympiad (IJSO)), National Talent Search Examinations (NTSE), Pre Regional Mathematics Olympiad (PreRMO), 1st stage of International Mathematics Olympiad). In addition to these competitive examinations, we also prepare students for class X board examination, according to the latest changes made in it, by CBSE, by exposing them to mock situations like that of the real one.
- In Sub-Junior classes, the targeted competitive examinations are National Mathematics Talent Competitions (NMTC), Private Mathematics and Science Olympiads and other private Olympiads which can be cleared by following CBSE curriculum of the particular class. Other than the competitive examinations, we build conceptual understanding in all the subjects by following NCERT curriculum and conducting various academic workshops to make students understand the application of several concepts.

Core Features of Pre-Foundation Division

Academic Excellence



Students are provided with an yearly exam card consisting of all the schedules of Part Tests(PTs), Cumulative Tests(CTs), Half Yearly test series and Pre-Board Test Series. This planner helps students and parents in planning the strategy for studies and progress ahead.

Classroom teaching is supplemented with futuristic study material in the form of chapter modules, which provide sequential theory of a particular chapter with questions at regular intervals to check the progress of students. At the end of the chapter, pictorial and textual summaries are given for a quick revision at the time of tests. After the summaries, exercises are given with carefully selected questions of different types and difficulty levels for comprehensive practice.

SUPPORT AND COMMUNICATION MECHANISM

There is provision of motivational classes within the curriculum which is required to keep the students on track and motivate them to aspire for success. As students of this age require continuous guidance, these motivation sessions help them to set their targets and fix the execution guidelines to achieve them.





There is a provision of PTSM which ensures periodic communication among the parents, teachers and students. 

Terms & Conditions

Resonance National Entrance Test (ResoNET)

- ▶ ResoNET registration closes 4 days before the Test Date.
- ► To take admission in particular Classroom Program & Phase, the students can appear in any two ResoNET by paying **reappearance fee ₹ 200** & the best of those would be considered for preparing the Final Merit List. His/her roll no. would remain the same for all the tests.
- The ResoNET result will be declared after 6 days of conduction of exam. It will be announced on our website www.pccp.resonance.ac.in and also communicated through SMS.
- The decision of Resonance will be final in all the respects and no communication will be entertained.
- Resonance reserves the right to change, or cancel this test at any time, without any prior notice.
- ▶ The Application Form Fee paid by student shall not be refunded in any case.

Scholarship

- The scholarship is valid for one year only i.e. for academic session: 2019-20 (Availed or Not availed)
- The scholarships shall be applicable to a student only after taking admission in respective program (at Kota/Authorized Study Centre of Resonance across India).
- > Student can avail only best of one scholarship in case he/she is eligible for more than one scholarship under different criteria by Resonance through any other scholarship program.
- A student appeared in ResoFAST and have taken admission in Resonance as stated earlier; shall not be allowed to appear in ResoNET on the basis of same enrolment number & his/her course fee shall not be transferred to any other course.
- The performance of a student in ResoFAST & ResoNET is independent & the performance linked scholarships of both the tests cannot be linked and are non-transferable.
- Scholarship may vary studycenter wise.
- Decision regarding Scholarships, Fee Benefits, Due Dates of Fee Deposition, Course/Medium/Study Centre Transfer etc. are discretionary rights of Institute's Management.

Course Fee

- ▶ All figures of fee are in **Indian Rupees** (INR).
- ▶ The Fee Structure is for one-year only i.e. Academic Session 2019-20.
- ► The Total Course Fee includes Tuition Fee + Caution Money + GST.
- The Fee Structure for Nagpur Study Centre Only. It may be similar or different than this at other Study Centers of Resonance. The students/parents are advised to explore/verify the Fee Structure at respective Study Centre wherever they are interested to enroll for PCCPs in Resonance through ResoNET.
- The Rate of GST & Education Cess is subjected to revision by the Government of India. Hence, the rate of GST may increase/decrease in future and shall be passed to the students accordingly. The students shall be informed at appropriate time about the same in case Government of India announces any change.
