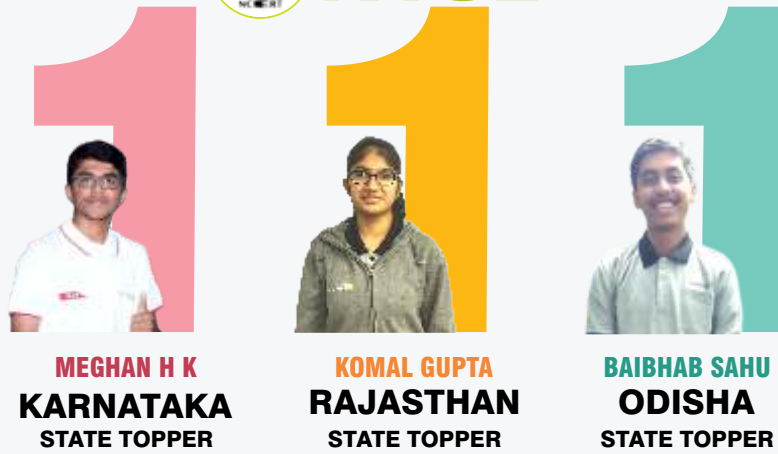

ABOUT

PCCP DIVISION

Resonance launched Pre-foundation Career Care Programs (PCCPs) Division in 2006 with the philosophy of an early start. As the name suggests, the division aims at giving the edge to the students for Career Examinations like JEE (Main + Advanced), NEET/ AIIMS, CA/CS/CLAT etc. before entering into senior secondary classes.

In last 13 years, PCCP division has evolved significantly and works in two segments of classes, namely, Sub-Junior classes (5th – 8th) and Junior classes (9th – 10th). The two segments have different teaching methodologies and so are their targets.

In junior classes, the targeted competitive examinations are National Standard Examination in Junior Science (NSEJS, 1st stage of International Junior Science Olympiad (IJSO)), National Talent Search Examination (NTSE), Pre Regional Mathematics Olympiad (PreRMO, 1st stage of International Mathematics Olympiad). In addition to these competitive examinations, we also prepare students for class 10th board examination, according to the latest changes made in it, by exposing them to mock situations like that of the real one.

In Sub-Junior classes, the targeted competitive examinations are National Mathematics Talent Competitions (NMTC), Private Mathematics and Science Olympiads and other private Olympiads which can be cleared by following CBSE curriculum of the particular class. Other than the competitive examinations, we build conceptual understanding in all the subjects by following NCERT curriculum and conducting various academic workshops to make students understand the application of several concepts.

Other than the academic delivery of concepts in Sub-Junior classes, we also aim at inculcating life skills in students as per the current guidelines of World Health Organization (WHO). The life skills include social skills, thinking skills and emotional skills. These skills are enhanced through a variety of activities conducted at the campus of each study center of Resonance.

Pre-defined Yearly Planner

The yearly planner consists of arrayed chapters for each subjects, test grid of whole session with syllabus mentioned in it, holiday schedule, homework checking schedule, etc.



All India Testing

The concepts learnt and practiced by the students are tested through regular tests mentioned in the yearly planner and conducted among the students of Resonance across all the study centers. This helps students to check their performance at the national level.

Scientifically Designed Chapter Modules

Classroom teaching is supplemented with futuristic study material in the form of chapter modules, which provide sequential theory of a particular chapter with exercises to check the progress of students, pictorial and textual summaries.



School Examination Preparatory (SEP) Sheets

These are worksheets which are to be solved and submitted for checking, after each chapter.



Regular Classroom Discussion of Homework Questions

After classroom teaching, homework is given to students, which is discussed in the next class of that particular subject. Students who do regular homework and participate in classroom discussion are likely to succeed in the competitive examinations.



Clinic Classes & Doubt Classes

Clinic and Doubt classes are for those students who miss out on classes due to unavoidable circumstances or late joining. These classes run throughout the year so that students can catch up anytime they feel left out.



Enhanced Classroom Teaching with Learning Aids

In classrooms, faculty members employ latest technologies to deliver topics in the most interesting and possible manner to maximize the absorption of concepts.



Daily Practice Problems (DPPs)

In addition to chapter modules, DPPs are given to students. Each DPP includes questions from all the chapters taught before it, even if they've already been covered in earlier DPPs.

Psychological cum Academic Counselling

Terms & Conditions

Resonance Forward Admission cum Scholarship Test (ResoFAST)

- ▶ ResoFAST registration closes 4 days before the Test Date.
- ▶ To take admission in particular Classroom Program & Phase, the students can appear in any two ResoFAST by paying **reappearance fee ₹ 200** & the best of those would be considered for preparing the Final Merit List. His/her roll no. would remain the same for all the tests.
- ▶ The ResoFAST result will be declared after 6 days of conduction of exam. It will be announced on our website www.pccp.resonance.ac.in and also communicated through SMS.
- ▶ The decision of Resonance will be final in all the respects and no communication will be entertained.
- ▶ Resonance reserves the right to change, or cancel this test at any time, without any prior notice.
- ▶ The Application Form Fee paid by student shall not be refunded in any case.

Scholarship

- ▶ The scholarship is valid for one year only i.e. for academic session: 2020-21 (Availed or Not availed)
- ▶ The scholarships shall be applicable to a student only after taking admission in respective program and it may vary with other Study Centres.
- ▶ Student can avail only **best of one scholarship** in case he/she is eligible for more than one scholarship under different criteria by Resonance through any other scholarship program.
- ▶ Scholarship will not be applicable on Study Material Fee (SMP)
- ▶ A student appeared in ResoFAST and have taken admission in Resonance as stated earlier; shall not be allowed to appear in ResoNET on the basis of same enrolment number & his / her course fee shall not be transferred to any other course.
- ▶ The performance of a student in ResoFAST & ResoNET is independent & the performance linked scholarships of both the tests cannot be linked and are non-transferable.
- ▶ Decision regarding Scholarships, Fee Benefits, Due Dates of Fee Deposition, Course/Medium/Study Centre Transfer etc. are discretionary rights of Institute's Management.

Course Fee

- ▶ All figures of fee are in **Indian Rupees (INR)**.
- ▶ The Fee Structure is for one-year only i.e. Academic Session 2020-21.
- ▶ Advance Registration Fee (ARF) is non-refundable. ARF amount does not include caution money (₹ 2000).
- ▶ If Full Fee paid, refund will be done after deducting ARF (Advanced Registration Fee) amount.
- ▶ The Fee Structure mentioned for the Academic Session 2020-21 is valid only for the students who have enrolled for the session 2020-21.
- ▶ The Total Course Fee includes Course Fee + GST + Caution Money.
- ▶ The Fee Structure for Jaipur Study Centre Only. It may be similar or higher than this at other Study Centers of Resonance. The students/parents are advised to explore/verify the Fee Structure at respective Study Centre wherever they are interested to enroll for PCCPs in Resonance through ResoFAST.
- ▶ The Rate of GST & Education Cess is subjected to revision by the Government of India. Hence, the rate of GST may increase/decrease in future and shall be passed to the students accordingly. The students shall be informed at appropriate time about the same in case Government of India announces any change.

- ▶ If ARF is paid, the last date of remaining I-installment is **28th February 2020** & last date of II-installment is **30th April 2020**, after that ResoNET Fee will be applicable.
- ▶ Students **Batch List** will be displayed by 31st March 2020. List will include the students details who will pay 1st Installment completely by due date.
- ▶ For Refund Rules of Regular & refer to **"Rule Book"** (PCCP).
