Achievements at a glance

- ▶ Resonance was founded on 11th April, 2001 by Mr. R.K. Verma, B.Tech, Electrical and Electronics from IIT Madras. Coming from an obscure town to becoming the top educationist in the field of education, enabling students from all part of the country to realize their dreams of IIT.
- ▶ The Distance Learning Program Division, established during the academic year of 2005-06, it provides course materials for JEE (Advanced), JEE (Main), NEET, KVPY, NTSE, IJSO, CBSE and other National and International Olympiads.
- ▶ The Pre-foundation Career Care Program (PCCP) was launched in 2006. Since then, it has been successfully preparing students for the competitive exams from classes V-VIII and IX-X onwards.
- ▶ The year 2011 saw the addition of AIEEE/JEE (MAIN) & NEET(AIPMT) Division and programs for the students of Class VII to X, who want to appear in National Talent Search Examination (NTSE) & International Olympiads.

- In the year 2008-09, a student from Resonance secured a Top-10 Rank in IIT-JEE for the first time. Anvit Singh Tanwar from Resonance Classroom Program secured AIR 09 in IIT-JEE.
- Resonance students bagged AIR-2 and AIR-5 in IIT-JEE 2011 and it was one of the best performances in IIT-JEE (JEE-Adv)
- Kalpit Veerwal, another student of Resonance's Classroom Coaching Program created history in 2016-17. Kalpit achieved the classic score of 360/360 in JEE Main 2017 and his effort found a mention in the Limca Book of Records.
- Pawan Goyal made the most of it in 2017-18. Pawan secured AIR 4 in JEE Advanced and AIR 6 in JEE (Main) in 2017-18. He bagged the highest marks 350 / 360 in JEE Main and this was the second consecutive year when a student of Resonance secured highest marks in JEE (Main).
 He also claimed the prestigious Gold medal at International Physics Olympiad (IPhO) 2018.
- RESONite Shubhankar Gambhir from Yearlong Classroom Contact Program kept Resonance's Success Flag high and achieved yet another 100
 Percentile in JEE (Main) 2019.
- For Four times, students of Resonance secured 100 Percentile & they have set a milestone for others to follow.

- A Non-refundable Advance Registration Fee [ARF] of INR 15000 is to be paid to confirm the admission and avail the benefit of early fee deposition. This ARF will be part from the first Installment.
- The Fee Structure mentioned above is for Lucknow Study Centre
 Only. It may be higher/lower or similar than this at other Study
 Centres of Resonance. The Students/Parents are advised to
 explore/verify the Fee Structure at respective Study Centre
 wherever they are interested to enroll for YCCPs in Resonance
 through ResoNET.
- 3. The Total Course Fee includes Admission Fee(AF), Study Material Fee (SMF), Tuition Fee (TF)

- 4. For Students who are depositing the Fee in 2 or more installments, it is mandatory for them to submit a Post Dated Cheque (PDCs) for the remaining installments at the time of depositing the 1st Installment.
- 5. The Rates of GST are as decided by Govt. of India and are subject to revision. Hence, the rate/amount of GST may increase/decrease or any other tax may be introduced in future. Scholarship & Rewards

There are some Terms & Conditions to be fulfilled by the Student to become eligible for Scholarship under GSP. These are:

- 1. These Scholarships will be valid only for ResoNET 2022 conducted for complete course.
- 2. The scholarship granted shall be applicable on Total Tuition Fee applicable for the course.
- 3. A Student can avail only one type of Scholarship at a time/in one Academic Session (Best of All).
- 4. All the Scholarships will be disbursed in the form of Fee Concession/Discount.
- 5. If a Student pays full fee in advance & becomes eligible for any other "better" scholarship then his excess amount will be refunded through NEFT (only) in designated account.
- 6. The Student has to submit photocopy of an authentic document proving his/her eligibility to avail the disbursement of scholarship amount under GSP.
- 7. If a Student receives any of the rewards as mentioned above during the course period & if he/she decides to leave the institute/withdraw from the course/shows continuous/ frequent absenteeism before the completion of course at any stage; the institute will have all the rights to recover the reward amount/any other financial expenses incurred from the Student. This may involve legal proceedings; if
- 8. A Student eligible for the above Scholarships Program may be denied or may be stripped off from the scholarship if his/her name is published/declared in public domain by any other institute/organization as a classroom/distance learning/e-learning Student to take the credit of his/her selection as a part of its promotional strategy. The institute will have all the rights to recover the Scholarship amount/any other financial expenses incurred from the student. This may involve legal proceedings; if required.
- 9. Any Scholarship is within discretionary power of Resonance & is not a matter of right for a student .Resonance reserves the right to increase/decrease/remove scholarship categories mentioned above at any point of time & without explaining any reason. Decision of Managing Director of Resonance shall be final in this regard.
