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Achievements at a glance

- Practice, persistence and performance when inculcated in the meticulous guidance of master minds are sure to produce the output of excellence in terms of career and development of holistic personality, and this is the mere objective of a brand called Resonance.
- Resonance was founded on 11th April, 2001 by Mr. R.K. Verma, B.Tech, Electrical and Electronics from IIT Madras. Coming from an obscure town to becoming the top educationist in the field of education, enabling students from all part of the country to realize their dreams of IIT.
- The Distance Learning Program Division, established during the academic year of 2005-06, it provides course materials for JEE (Advanced), JEE (Main), NEET, KVPY, NTSE, USO, CBSE and other National and International Olympiads.
- The Pre-foundation Career Care Program (PCCP) was launched in 2006. Since then, it has been successfully preparing students for the competitive exams from classes V-VIII and IX-X onwards.
- The year 2011 saw the addition of AIEEE/JEE (MAIN) & NEET(AIPMT) Division and programs for the students of Class VII to X, who want to appear in National Talent Search Examination (NTSE) & International Olympiads.

NEET Information

About NEET Exam

The Central Government has established the National Testing Agency to conduct entrance examination for admission/fellowship in higher educational institutions. About PCCP DIVISION

Resonance launched Pre-foundation Career Care Programs (PCCPs) Division in 2006 with the philosophy of an early start. As the name suggests, the division aims at giving the edge to the students for Career Examinations like JEE (Main + Advanced), NEET/AIIMS, CA/CS/CLAT etc. before entering into senior secondary classes.
