The application fee payment can be made by credit/debit card/ Paytm or by depositing fee in cash in the Syndicate/Canara/ICICI bank through e-challan generated during the online filling of application form.

Mode of Examination: Pen and paper based /Computer based Examination (ENGLISH /HINDI)

Eligibility:

- Only those candidates whose date of birth falls on or after **October 01, 1993** are eligible. However, in the case of Scheduled Caste (SC), Scheduled Tribe (ST) and Persons with Disabilities (PwD) candidates, upper age limit is relaxed by 5 years, i.e. SC, ST and PwD candidates who are born on or after **October 01, 1988** are eligible.
- For the candidates to qualify for the admission in the IITs/NITs/IIITs and such other CFTIs whose admissions are based on the JEE (Advanced)/JEE(Main) ranks, they should have secured at least 75% marks in the 12th class examination, or be in the top 20 percentile in the 12th class examination conducted by the respective Boards. For SC/ST students the qualifying marks would be 65% in the 12th class examination.
- A candidate can attempt JEE (MAIN) a maximum of three times in consecutive years. Therefore, candidates who appeared in JEE (Main) 2016 for the first time are also eligible.

In Case of Improvement:

- If a candidate has passed Class 12th/ Equivalent qualifying examination from one state but appeared for improvement from another state, his/her state code of eligibility will be from where he/she has originally passed Class 12th/ Equivalent qualifying examination and not the state from where he/she has appeared for improvement. Candidate passed/appearing class 12th from NIOS should select the State of Eligibility according to the state in which the study centre is located. The State of Eligibility is not applicable for the candidates belonging to Nepal /Bhutan/Foreign/OCI/PIO.
- If a candidate passes Class XII in 2017 but writes one or a few subjects in 2018 for improvement or any other reason, then top 20 percentile cut-off for 2017 will be considered. However, if a candidate writes all the subjects in 2018, then the best of the two performances will be considered.

Instructions for form filling:

Before filling up the application form the candidate should have a scanned image of his/her photograph, signature and **father's/mother's/guardian's signature**. These scanned images are to be uploaded during the submission of application form. The photograph should be colour or b/w (but clear contrast) with name of the candidate and date of taking the photograph printed on it. **Aadhar is Compulsory for JEE MAIN-2018 Aspirants.**
